ALZHEIMER DISEASE is the most common type of dementia – 50 to 60% of all cases of Dementia, affecting mostly elderly persons.

It is associated with wide spread neuro-degenerative damage of brain tissue. It results in a decline of the mental and cognitive function,



especially memory, language, judgment and thinking and interferes with daily activities and social relationships

It usually runs a progressive course although it can be step by step; it is irreversible and ultimately fatal.

For people aged over 60 it is the second leading cause of years lived with disability (WHO 2004)

With the ageing of the world's population and the increasing number of people aged over 60 there will be a substantial increase in the number of people with dementia.

Worldwide there are about 35 million persons with Alzheimer Disease (2009 ADI report) and In MAURITIUS it was estimated in 2007 that around 6,000 persons had Alzheimer's disease.

The Staff

We have paid staff and volunteers working at the Day Care Centre Monday to Friday 8.30 am to 3.30 pm

The clients, 14 to 16 patients daily are managed by our dedicated staff, with the maintenance of a domestic atmosphere.



The Day Care Centre

The company of other people and the activities provided in the centre help to stimulate the person with dementia and AD. Many of the activities at day care centre aim to maintain some of the residual skills and their autonomy. Also when a family leaves its older person with us for the day, respite is given to the families, who are free to continue with their normal daily activities.

These activities include following:

Reminiscence

Indoor games

Table manners and hygiene

Entertainment and hobbies

Music and dance

Physical exercise

Massage and relaxation

Outings



LA ROSA DAY CARE CENTRE (a branch of the Association Alzheimer)

Association Alzheimer is collaborating with the Senior Citizens Associations of the Grand Port District and the Ministry of Social Security, in setting up Day Care Activities for 20 persons with dementia and AD twice a week (Tuesdays and Thursdays), at the La Rosa Elderly Day Care Centre (EDCC) from 9.30 am to 2.00 pm, starting in June 2014

20 Senior Citizens volunteers have been identified and trained at the Alzheimer Centre to take care of the persons with dementia at la Rosa EDCC. A public awareness has been done for all members of the senior citizens association of the Grand Port District by the professionals of the Association Alzheimer. A survey form has been prepared to help in locating the persons with dementia and to motivate them and their families to attend the La Rosa EDCC.

Association Alzheimer will support the day care centre in preparing the activities, donate games and materials and continue with the training of the volunteers and families at the La Rosa EDCC.
